

Belgian Ultimate Indoor Championship 2010-2011 (BUIC1011)

1. System

33 (not a new record!) teams are playing in this year's BUIC. We will play in 2 mixed divisions (9 teams in total) and 5 open divisions (24 teams in total).

In the mixed division we'll have 2 divisions. One of 5 teams, another of 4 teams.

In the open division the first 4 divisions contain 5 teams, division 5 contains 4 teams

Open divisions:

Starting positions will be based on the final ranking of BUIC0910. On each competition day all teams of 1 division will play against all other teams of that same division. This means 4 games per team per day, except for division 5 where the teams will play 3 games per day.

At the end of each day, the winner and runner-up of each division promotes to the division directly above (except for division 1), and the last and last-but-one team of each division descends to the division directly beneath (except for open division 5 and mixed division 2).

On each of the 4 days, the winner of open division 1 will receive 17 points, the second team in open division 1 will receive 16 points, the third team in open division 1 will receive 15 points, the fourth team in open division 1 will receive 14 points and the fifth team in open division 1 will receive 13 points.

The winner of open division 2 will receive 14 points, the second team of open division 2 will receive 13 points, the third team of open division 2 will receive 12 points and so on.

The last team in open division 5 will receive 2 points.

Basically scores will look like this in the open division :

The points from the 4 days will be added together to get a final ranking at the end of the season.

5 Teams will play the play-offs at the end of the season: the 5 open teams with the highest points at the end of day 4. In case of equal points in the final ranking we'll look to the Spirit Of The Game scores to rank the teams with equal points

The team that wins the play-offs will be the Belgian Open Indoor Champion 2010-2011

Mixed divisions:

Starting positions will be based on the final ranking of BUIC0910. On each competition day all teams of 1 division will play against all other teams of that same division. This means 4 games per team per day for division one and 3 games for division 2.

The winner of day one, two and three of division 1 receives 8 points, the second of div 1 will receive 7 points, the third of div 1 will receive 6 points, the fourth of div 1 will receive 5 points, the fifth of div 1 receives 4 points. The winner of division 2 receives 5 points, the second of div 2 receives 4 points, the third of div 2 receives 3 points and the fourth of div 2 receives 2 points.

After day 3 the ranking will be made. The 5 teams with the highest scores will play the play-offs on day four, the other 4 teams will play another round robin. In case of equal points in the final ranking we'll look to the Spirit Of The Game scores to rank the teams with equal points.

In the round robin for places 6 to 9 the points will be added to the ranking made up after day 3 to get the

final ranking. The teams playing the play-offs will play for place 1 to 5. The team who wins the play-offs will be Belgian Indoor Coed Champion

b. Some remarks :

- Teams playing coed this year are marked in green.
- KHK and Gentle Fusees won't participate this year.
- 2 "new" teams will join us : B-Freezzz (BFZ) and Slijpschijven (SLS) both playing in the coed division
- Frisbeeteam Helchteren changed it's name to Forza Haletra (FHL).

c. Starting position for this year's BUIC in the open division :

Division 1 : MC1, GBP, SL1, FBZ, HU1

Division 2 : DH1, FS1, XL1, EUL, MC3

Division 3 : GGP, ULB, HBZ, JET, MC2

Division 4 : SL2, FHL, SKY, FRB, HU2

Division 5 : XL3, DH2, FS2, DDR

Starting position for this year's BUIC in the mixed division, ranking day:

Division 1: SCH, DH, GBS, GGS, XL1

Division 2: XL2, GTO, BFZ, SLS

4. Rules

- Games of 25 minutes. Finish the point at the end-signal. If the score is equal after the last point has been played, you play 1 extra point to have a winner.
- A new point begins as soon as a team scores (so if time is over when a team is walking towards it's own side to receive the pull, that point still has to be played).
- Game ends immediately if a team reaches 13 points.
- If a game finishes sooner than 25 minutes because a team reaches 13 points, the next game will start no later than 3 minutes after the previous game.
- Brick-rule of 5 meters
- 1 Time-out per team per game. Time is not stopped during these time-outs, so no time-out allowed in the last 5 minutes of the game.
- Order of the games on a day in division 1 to 5 : 1-3, 2-4, 3-5, 1-4, 2-5, 3-4, 1-2, 4-5, 2-3, 1-5. The team (or one of the teams) playing "home" i.e. in their own hall, will be team 1, the other teams will be ranked according to the ranking before the day. Exceptions can be made if necessary or in case none of the teams can play at home
- Order of the games on a day in open division 5 and mixed division 2 : to be determined day by day.
- Teams get 1 point for a victory and 0 for a defeat.
- At the end of each day a ranking is made per division. In case of equal points between 2 teams in a division the winner of the game between those 2 teams comes first. If more than 2 teams have the same number of points we use this system : first we look at the goal-average of their opposing games only, then we look at the scored points of their opposing games, then we look at the global goal-average of all their games in the division, then we look at the scored points of all their games in the division. If we still can't decide who comes first, we look at the total-ranking before that day, or the final ranking of last year in case of a tie on day 1.
- At the end of each day : in open division 2 to 5 and in mixed division 2 : first and second team goes up. In open division 1 to 4 and in mixed division 1: last and last team but one goes down.
- Per minute a team is too late to have at least 4 players on the field, after the starting signal has been given, the opposing team gets an extra point to it's score for that game (so after 4 minutes the score would be 4-0). If a team doesn't have a minimum of 4 players 5 minutes after the starting signal, the team loses the game with 0-13, and will get -10 on their total points.
- If a team doesn't show up on a certain day, 20 points will be subtracted from their total. The team won't go down 1 but 2 divisions ! This will also have consequences for next year's BUIC : the team will be put on the waiting list, so if there will be more than enough teams to participate, this team won't be able to play.
- A player having played in a certain team CANNOT play with another team (from the same or another club) in this year's championship. After each day, every team has to send a list of the players having played that day to glenn.nolf@gmail.com.

- At the end of each day :

for the open division:

- The winner of division 1 will receive 17 points, the second team in division 1 will receive 16 points, the third team in division 1 will receive 15 points, the fourth team in division 1 will receive 14 points and the fifth team in division 1 will receive 13 points.
The winner of division 2 will receive 14 points, the second team of division 2 will receive 13 points, the third team of division 2 will receive 12 points and so on.
The last team in division 5 will receive 2 points.
- After 4 days all points are added to get a global ranking.
- There will be no more Golden Tickets. After day 4 the play-offs will be played with the 5 teams who have the highest scores. In case of equal points in the final ranking we'll look at the Spirit Of The Game scores to rank the teams with equal points
- Play-offs will be played with 5 teams, who will all start with 0 points. Round-robin, so 4 games per team. The team that wins the play-offs will be Belgian Indoor Champion 2010-2011. In case of an equal ranking for 2 or more teams, we use the same system as described earlier on. (the system we use during the competition days, so not the spirit scores)

for the mixed division:

- on the end of day 1, 2 and day 3:
The winner of div 1 receives 8 points, the second of div 1 will receive 7 points, the third of div 1 will receive 6 points, the fourth of div 1 will receive 5 points, the fifth of div 1 receives 4 points. The winner of division 2 receives 5 points, the second of div 2 receives 4 points, the third of div 2 receives 3 points, the fourth of div 2 receives 2 points
- After day 3 the ranking will be made. The 5 teams with the highest scores will play the play-offs on day four. In case of equal points in the final ranking we'll look to the Spirit Of The Game scores to rank the teams with equal points.
- Play-offs will be played with 5 teams, who will all start with 0 points. Round-robin, so 4 games per team. The team that wins the play-offs will be Belgian Indoor Coed Champion 2010-2011. In case of an equal ranking for 2 or more teams, we use the same system as described earlier on (the system we use during the competition days, so not the spirit scores)
- The other 4 teams who will not play the play-offs will play another round robin. In this round robin the points will be added to the ranking made up after day 3 to get the final ranking. The teams playing the play-offs will play for place 1 to 5.

5. Spirit of the game

- At the end of each day, every team has to fill out the spirit of the game sheets for each opponent they played.
- Please read the instructions on the Spirit of the Game documents carefully! Spirit of the game is much more than just being a good looking, hard partying team...
- The team that has the most points at the end of day 4 will get the spirit of the game award. (one for the open and one for the mixed division)

8. Costs

Since the teams in open division 5 and mixed division 2 will have 1 game per day less than the other teams, they will get a discount. Every team from open division 5 and mixed division 2 will get a refund of 10 euro per day. This could add up to 40 euro in case your team always plays in D5. The refund will be paid back at the end of the BUIC1011.
